CHAPTER 26

(House Bill 85)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages - Board of License Commissioners

FOR the purpose of eliminating the requirement that the Comptroller approve the employment and compensation of certain employees of the boards of license commissioners.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 158(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

158.

- (b) The respective board shall be authorized to employ a secretary and such inspectors, clerical and other assistance as may be necessary, and to fix the compensation of such employees, [subject to the approval of the Comptroller,] except as otherwise provided by this article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 27

(House Bill 116)

AN ACT concerning

Religious Corporations - Trustees

FOR the purpose of providing for an exemption from the requirement that the minister of a church, or if applicable the senior minister of a church, be a trustee of the religious corporation.
