Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Volume and 1983 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - Environmental

[Subtitle 11. Miscellaneous Drug and Cosmetic Provisions] [4-1101.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
 - (b) "Barbiturate" means:
- (1) A salt or derivative of barbituric acid, also known as malonylurea, that has a sleep inducing action; or
- (2) A compound of any preparation or mixture of these.
- (c) "Delivery" includes selling, dispensing, giving away, and supplying in any other manner.
 - (d) (1) "Manufacturer" means a person who:
 - (i) Is not a pharmacist; and
 - (ii) Manufactures barbiturates.
- (2) "Manufacturer" includes a person who prepares barbiturates in dosage forms by mixing, compounding, encapsulating, entableting, or other process.
 - (e) "Patient" means:
- (1) An individual for whom a barbiturate is prepared or administered; or
- (2) The owner or an agent of the owner of an animal for which a barbiturate is prescribed or to which a barbiturate is administered.
- (f) "Pharmacist" means a pharmacist who is licensed by the State Board of Pharmacy.
- (g) "Practitioner" means a person who is authorized by law to prescribe and administer barbiturates.
- (h) "Prescription" means an oral or written order by a practitioner to a pharmacist for a barbiturate for a particular patient.
