- (a) (1) The court shall determine the amount of and the period for an award of alimony.
- (2) THE COURT MAY AWARD ALIMONY FOR A PERIOD BEGINNING FROM THE FILING OF THE PLEADING THAT REQUESTS ALIMONY.
- [(2)] (3) At the conclusion of the period of the award of alimony, no further alimony shall accrue.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 214

(House Bill 695)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Purchasing Property
