CHAPTER 237

(House Bill 900)

AN ACT concerning

Juvenile Law - Alcohol-Related Offenses - Intake

FOR the purpose of providing that a citation of a juvenile for violation of certain criminal provisions dealing with alcohol consumption by minors shall be forwarded to the State's Attorney if the child fails to fellow-the-directions of-the-intake-officer-to-attend-an-alcohol-rehabilitation program-or-a-supervised-work-program comply with the intake officer's alcohol rehabilitation program referral or supervised work program assignment; clarifying language; and generally relating to the processing of juveniles for alcohol violations.
