CHAPTER 238

(House Bill 913)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Special Registration Plates for Disabled Persons - Prohibition

FOR the purpose of providing that a person who operates a motor vehicle with a special disabled person's registration number may not use certain privileges unless the person, or a certain dependent or individual who accompanies the person, meets certain requirements.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

13-616.

- (a) (1) The owner of any vehicle described in paragraph (2) of this subsection may apply to the Administration for the assignment to that vehicle of a special, disabled person's registration number, if the applicant, a dependent of the applicant, or any individual who depends on the applicant for transportation:
- (i) Has permanently lost the use of a leg or an arm;
- (ii) Is so severely and permanently disabled as to be unable to move without a wheelchair or crutches;
- (iii) So suffers from lung disease that his forced expiratory volume, one second, when measured by spirometry, is less than one liter;
