(House Bill 1143)

AN ACT concerning

Oysters - Use of Patent Tongs

FOR the purpose of altering the areas in which a person may use patent tongs instead of hand tongs to catch oysters on certain natural oyster bars.

- (a) In this subtitle, the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (o) "Patent tongs" means any pincers, nippers, tongs, or similar device used to catch oysters and clams raised with rope, cable, or other hoisting gear.
