(m) [(1)] "Low-level nuclear waste" means a substance that:

[(i)] (1) Contains or is contaminated with radioactive material emitting primarily beta or gamma radiation; and

[(ii)] (2) Is neither transuranic waste nor high-level nuclear waste.

(a) In addition to the other requirements of this subtitle, each county plan shall:

(3) Show compliance with [items] PARAGRAPHS (1) and (2) of this subsection by using graphic and tabular information;

(6) Contain adequate information about:

(iii) Projections for use of sewage treatment plant capacity based on:

[A.] 1. Outstanding building permits and subdivision plats if the county has subdivision authority; or

[B.] 2. Zoning commitments if the county does not have subdivision authority;
