THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL LEVY ANNUALLY UPON THE PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE DISTRICT A SUM SUFFICIENT TO REPAY WHATEVER BONDS ARE ISSUED BY THEM, THE FUNDS FROM WHICH ARE USED FOR DISTRICT PURPOSES. THIS LEVY SHALL BE COLLECTED AS ALL OTHER TAXES IN THE COUNTY ARE COLLECTED AND SHALL BE PAID OVER TO THE COUNTY TREASURER FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF AMORTIZING THE BOND ISSUE OR ISSUES SPECIFIED IN § 4A-3.

MONEY MAY NOT BE EXPENDED UNTIL THERE IS A BINDING AGREEMENT THAT ALL PRIVATELY OWNED ROADS COMMONLY USED BY THE PUBLIC AT LARGE ARE DEEDED TO THE COUNTY AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN BROUGHT UP TO APPROPRIATE STANDARDS.

~~(A) -- ANY EMPLOYEE OR AGENT OF THE DISTRICT BOARD HAS THE RIGHT OF ENTRY AT ALL REASONABLE HOURS UPON ANY PRIVATELY OWNED LAND IN THE DISTRICT WHILE IN PURSUIT OF HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES UPON FIRST PRESENTING PROPER CREDENTIALS FROM THE DISTRICT BOARD. -- ANY RESTRAINT OR HINDRANCE OFFERED TO SUCH ENTRY BY ANY OWNER, TENANTS, AGENT OF THE OWNER, OR OTHER PERSON IS PROHIBITED.~~

~~(B) -- ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$100 FOR EACH OCCURRENCE.~~

AN ACT concerning

Code Revision - Terminology
