

10-304. TRANSFER OF PROPERTY BETWEEN UNITS OF EXECUTIVE BRANCH.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:

(1) PROPERTY THAT IS PLEDGED TO SECURE THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL OF OR INTEREST ON REVENUE BONDS; OR

(2) REAL PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION.

(B) POWER OF BOARD.

(1) THE BOARD MAY TRANSFER ANY PROPERTY, AND ALL RIGHTS OF PHYSICAL CUSTODY AND CONTROL OVER THE PROPERTY, FROM A UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT TO ANOTHER UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

(2) ANY PROPERTY TRANSFERRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE CONTINUING GENERAL JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 78A, § 16(a).

In subsection (b)(1) of this section, the word "unit" is substituted for the former references to a "board, bureau, commission or other agency", to conform to provisions elsewhere in this article.

Also in subsection (b)(1) of this section, the words "real and personal", which formerly modified reference to "property", are deleted as surplusage.

10-305. TRANSFERS OF STATE REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY -- IN GENERAL.

(A) POWER; CONSIDERATION; CONDITIONS.

ANY REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE STATE OR A UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT MAY BE SOLD, LEASED, TRANSFERRED, EXCHANGED, GRANTED, OR OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF:

(1) TO ANY PERSON, TO THE UNITED STATES OR ANY OF ITS UNITS, OR TO ANY UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT, FOR A CONSIDERATION THE BOARD DECIDES IS ADEQUATE; OR

(2) TO ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THE STATE SUBJECT TO ANY CONDITIONS THE BOARD IMPOSES.

(B) EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS -- IN GENERAL.
