WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT AN ADMINISTRATOR OF THE BOARDS FOR A TERM OF 6 YEARS.

(B) SALARY AND ASSISTANCE.

THE ADMINISTRATOR IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY AND NECESSARY ASSISTANCE AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(C) GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES.

IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS ARTICLE, THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL:

- (1) PREPARE AND PROVIDE NOTICES AND REPORTS REQUIRED OF BOARDS INCLUDING UNIFORM FORMS, ORDER BLANKS, AND STATEMENTS ADVISING TAXPAYERS OF THEIR RIGHT TO APPEAL;
- (2) KEEP A RECORD OF COMPLAINTS ABOUT THE CONDUCT OR FITNESS OF MEMBERS; AND
- (3) FORWARD TO THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY OFFICIALS LISTED IN § 3-103(D)(2) OF THIS TITLE COMPLAINTS THAT WOULD JUSTIFY REMOVAL OF A MEMBER.

(D) REGULATIONS.

- (1) SUBJECT TO TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL:
- (I) ADOPT UNIFORM REGULATIONS TO GOVERN THE ACTIVITIES OF THE BOARDS; AND
- (II) ENSURE THAT THE REGULATIONS ARE APPLIED CONSISTENTLY.
- (2) AFTER ADOPTION, REGULATIONS SHALL BE FILED WITH THE MARYLAND TAX COURT AND THE COURT OF APPEALS.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 81, §§ 248(c)(2) and 224A(a), (c), and the third sentence of (b).

In the introductory language of subsection (c) of this section, the phrase "[i]n addition to the powers and duties set forth elsewhere in this article" is added to clarify that this subsection is not an exclusive list of the Administrator's powers and duties.

In subsection (c)(3) of this section, the reference to "county officials listed in § 3-103(d)(2)" is substituted for the reference to "local officials", for accuracy.
