

Wicomico County - Sheriff - Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Wicomico County; and providing that this Act shall not affect the incumbent.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-309.

(x) (1) The Sheriff of Wicomico County shall receive a salary of [[\$20,000] \$28,000. He shall appoint a chief deputy at a salary of at least \$5,000 as set by the Wicomico County Council, payable in equal monthly installments. His term of office coincides with the Sheriff's and he may be removed by the Sheriff at any time. The Sheriff may appoint additional deputies as he and the County Council of Wicomico County deem necessary, each of whom shall receive the compensation prescribed by the personnel rules and regulations of the county.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35, of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Wicomico County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Wicomico County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
