- (v) Labor.
- (vi) Management.
- (vii) Legal profession.
- (viii) Medical profession.
- (ix) Mental health associations.
- (x) State and local government.
- (xi) Private employee groups.
- (xii) Local citizens groups.
- (xiii) Major socio-economic and ethnic groups.
- (b) (1) The term of a member is 3 years.
- (2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the [State] MARYLAND Advisory Council on July 1, 1982. The terms of one third of those members end each year.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

10-303.

- (a) From among its members, the [State] MARYLAND Advisory Council shall elect a chairman and a vice chairman.
- (b) The manner of election of officers and their terms of office shall be as the [State] MARYLAND Advisory Council determines.

10-304.

- (a) (1) The [State] MARYLAND Advisory Council shall meet at the times and places that it determines.
- (2) At least 2 meetings a year shall be held jointly with the State Advisory Council on Alcoholism Control and the State Advisory Council on Drug Abuse.
 - (b) A member of the [State] MARYLAND Advisory Council:
