

hundred dollars (\$500.00). Notwithstanding the license tax, costs paid by the Maryland State Police in securing records from any other source shall be charged to the applicant; however, the charges assessed against the applicant may not exceed \$12.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 50

(House Bill 277)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - Merit System

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Queen Anne's County Commissioners to include in the County's merit system the employees of the Queen Anne's County Sheriff's department; and generally relating to the powers and authority of the Queen Anne's County Commissioners and the County's merit system.
