- (D) [However, no] NO part of the sum shall be distributed to any fire department or station to be formed in the future which has not been approved by the St. Mary's County Fire Board.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 61

(House Bill 449)

AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages Licensee - Penalty

FOR the purpose of authorizing the St. Mary's County Board of License Commissioners to both revoke or suspend an alcoholic beverages license and impose a fine on a licensee for any violation of the alcoholic beverages law; and making stylistic changes.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 203(e) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

203.

- (e) In St. Mary's County, (1) for any violation of the laws as to licensing the sale of alcoholic beverages, the penalty upon conviction shall be a fine not exceeding [five hundred dollars] \$500.
- (2) For any violation of the laws as to hours or days for the sale of alcoholic beverages, the violator shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon trial and conviction shall be subjected to a fine of not less than [fifty dollars (\$50.00)] \$50 nor more than [two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00)] \$250 or may be confined in the county jail or the House of Correction for not less than sixty days.
