SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 20 - Somerset County

9-A.

- (A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SOMERSET COUNTY MAY APPOINT A COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR FOR SOMERSET COUNTY.
- (B) (1) THE TERM OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR IS 4 YEARS FROM-THE-1ST-TUESDAY-IN-DECEMBER-AFTER-THE-EQUNTY-ADMINISTRATOR'S APPOINTMENT---AND---QUALIFICATION: FROM THE FIRST TUESDAY IN DECEMBER, 1986 AND EVERY 4 YEARS THEREAFTER.
- (2) IF THE OFFICE OF COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR BECOMES VACANT BECAUSE OF DEATH, RESIGNATION, OR FOR INCOMPETENCY, OR OTHER DISQUALIFICATIONS FOR THE OFFICE, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY FILL THE VACANCY FOR THE PERIOD OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM.
- (C) THE SALARY OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR SHALL BE THE AMOUNT ANNUALLY SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
