

(II) THE ANNUAL FEE IS \$1,000; OR

(4) (I) A 6-DAY (ON- AND OFF-SALE) CLASS D BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR ON AND OFF PREMISE CONSUMPTION;

(II) THE ANNUAL FEE IS \$800.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 82

(House Bill 927)

AN ACT concerning

Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages - Social Events in
Veterans Organizations Halls
Ho. Co. 215A-85

FOR the purpose of providing that in Howard County certain prohibitions against bringing alcoholic beverages, for purposes of consumption, on the premises of the holder of an alcoholic beverages license do not apply to social events held in a hall rented from and located on the premises of a veterans organization licensed under Article 2B ("Alcoholic Beverages") of the Code.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(b) (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink on the licensed premises of any license holder any alcoholic beverages not purchased from the license holder on said premises and not permitted by this article to be consumed on the premises; and it shall be unlawful for any license holder to permit any person to
