Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- (m) In Carroll County, the board of license commissioners may impose a fine of not more than [\$1,000] \$2,000 or suspend a license for any violation that is cause for suspension under the alcoholic beverage laws affecting Carroll County.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 88

(House Bill 1037)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Licenses

FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that Class C beer, wine and liquor licenses can only be issued to clubs in Carroll County that serve full-course meals at least twice daily.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 20(e-2) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

20.

(e-2) (1) In Carroll County the annual fee for such a license shall be twelve hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250.00) for any club which is a local chapter of a nationally organized nonprofit fraternal or veterans' organization and fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) for any other club.
