- B. IS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE STATE HEALTH PLAN OR ANY THE INSTITUTION SPECIFIC PLAN DEVELOPED BY THE COMMISSION: AND
- C. WILL RESULT IN THE DELIVERY OF MORE EFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE HEALTH CARE SERVICES; AND
 - D. IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST.
- (3) WITHIN 45 DAYS OF RECEIVING NOTICE, THE COMMISSION SHALL NOTIFY THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY OF ITS FINDING.
- (j) (1) A certificate of need is required before the type or scope of any health care service is changed if the health care service is offered:
 - (i) By a health care facility;
- $\hbox{(ii)} \quad \hbox{In space that is leased from a health care} \\$
- (iii) In space that is on land leased from a health care facility.
 - (2) This subsection does not apply if:
- (i) The Commission adopts limits for changes in health care services and the proposed change would not exceed those limits;
- (ii) The proposed change would add a new health care service and, during a 1 year period, the annual operating revenue that would result from the addition is less than \$250,000 after an annual adjustment for inflation, based on an appropriate index specified by the Commission; [or]
- (iii) The proposed change would increase or decrease the volume of one patient service and, during a 2 year period, the change is less than 25 percent of that volume[.]; OR
- (IV) 1. AT LEAST 30 $\underline{45}$ DAYS BEFORE INCREASING OR DECREASING THE VOLUME OF 1 OR MORE PATIENT SERVICES, WRITTEN NOTICE OF INTENT TO CHANGE THE VOLUME OF PATIENT SERVICES IS FILED WITH THE COMMISSION; AND
- 2. WITHIN--30--DAYS--0F-RECEIVING-NOTICE, THE COMMISSION IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION FINDS THAT THE PROPOSED CHANGE:
- A. IS PURSUANT TO THE CONSOLIDATION OR MERGER OF 2 OR MORE HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, OR CONVERSION OF A HEALTH CARE FACILITY OR PART OF A FACILITY TO A NONHEALTH RELATED USE:
