

BOARDS FOR THE REMOVAL OF ASBESTOS OR OTHER HEALTH THREATENING SUBSTANCES FROM PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

(D) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR THE APPLICATION FOR, AND USE OF, ASBESTOS REMOVAL FUNDS.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal year 1986 only and from only those net revenues provided by the supplemental tobacco tax imposed by Section 1 of this Act, and from no other funds, and subject to the provisions of law relating to budgetary procedure to the extent applicable, the amounts specified below, or as much as is required to accomplish the designated purpose, is hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed from as much of the net revenues as are received by the State from the supplemental tobacco tax imposed by this Act:

23.05.03.02 Asbestos Removal Fund

In addition to the amount appropriated in the Budget Bill and Supplemental Budget for fiscal year 1986, the following amounts to be used for the specified purposes:

General Fund Appropriation . . . . . \$10,000,000.

SECTION -2-- 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 122

(Senate Bill 505)

AN ACT concerning

Public Education - Density Aid
