

(2) Except as hereinafter in subsection (d) provided, there shall be divided among and allocated and paid to the several counties of the State and to Baltimore City on the basis of population, according to the latest available federal census (a) twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) plus one-half of all breakage and license fees and two-fifths (2/5) of all wagering revenues collected from licensees licensed under § 7 of this article; (b) one-quarter of all revenues collected from licensees licensed under § 15 of this article; (c) one-half of all breakage and license fees, one-quarter (1/4) of all revenues arising out of the tax on all money wagered not in excess of \$2,000,000; and nine-twentieths (9/20) of all revenues arising out of the tax on all money wagered in excess of \$2,000,000 collected from licensees licensed under § 17 of this article not required to be paid to the Maryland Agricultural Fair Board as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, except that no funds shall be divided among, allocated or paid to any of the several counties of the State or to the City of Baltimore as aforesaid unless it shall have levied, in its current fiscal year, taxes sufficient to collect a minimum of one dollar per capita in revenue and unless it shall have certified a copy of said levy to the State Comptroller, and provided further, that any moneys otherwise distributable as hereinbefore provided, which shall not be distributed at the close of the fiscal year of any such county or the City of Baltimore because of failure of any county or the City of Baltimore to make such levy and certification, shall revert to the general fund of the State treasury. Per capita revenue shall be computed for purposes of this subsection by using the population figures furnished by the latest federal census or by an official local census, whichever is latest. }
