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CHAPTER 129

(Senate Bill 69)

AN ACT concerning

Medical Mutual Liability Insurance Society of Maryland

~~FOR the purpose of repealing provisions of law relating to the Medical Mutual Liability Insurance Society of Maryland, providing that if the insurance Commissioner finds that under certain circumstances a substantial number of physicians cannot obtain medical malpractice insurance, a new Physicians Mutual Liability Insurance Company of Maryland shall be created, providing for the establishment, management, and procedure of the new company, and generally relating to a mechanism for physicians to obtain liability insurance in this State.~~

FOR the purpose of allowing the Medical Mutual Liability Insurance Society of Maryland and its subsidiaries to issue liability and property insurance for physicians and other health care providers; allowing the Society and its subsidiaries to issue nonassessable policies upon meeting requirements of the law; allowing for the expansion of the board of directors of the Society; removing certain exemptions from the law; removing certain outdated provisions; and generally relating to the structure and activities of the Maryland Mutual Liability Insurance Society.
