- (a) The State Board consists of [nine] 9 members, AND 1 NONVOTING VOTING STUDENT MEMBER, appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (b) (1) In making appointments to the State Board, the Governor shall consider representation from:
  - (i) All parts of this State; and
- (ii) Areas of this State with concentrations of population or unique needs.
- (2) The  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right)$  members of the Board shall be appointed from the general public.
- (3) The following individuals may not be appointed to the Board:
- (i) Any EXCEPT FOR THE NONVOTING STUDENT VOTING MEMBER, ANY individual who is subject to the authority of the Board:
  - (ii) The Governor; and
  - (iii) The State Superintendent.
- (4)--THE--STUDENT--MEMBER--SHALL--BE--SELECTED--BY-THE GOVERNOR-FROM-AMONG-THE-FOLLOWING-4-NOMINEES:
- (1)--2--PERSONS--NOMINATED---BY---THE---MARYLAND ASSOCIATION-OF-STUDENT-COUNCILS;-AND
- (!!)--2--PERSONS--NOMINATED--BY--THE--GOVERNOR'S YOUTH-ADVISORY-COMMISSION:
- (4) THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL BE SELECTED BY THE GOVERNOR FROM AMONG THE FOLLOWING 4 NOMINEES:
- ASSOCIATION OF STUDENT COUNCILS; AND
- (II) 2 PERSONS NOMINATED BY THE GOVERNOR'S YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL.
  - (C) THE NONVOTING VOTING NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER SHALL BE:
    - (1) A REGULARLY ENROLLED STUDENT; AND
- (2) IN GOOD STANDING IN A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE STATE.
- [(c)] (D) (1) Each member serves for a term of 5 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on the State Board as of July 1, 1978.
