- (2) The seven members serving on the State Board as of June 30, 1976 are:
- (i) Members of the Board for the remainder of their terms; and
- (ii) Eligible for reappointment to the same extent as on June 30, 1976.
- (3) The Governor shall appoint a new member to fill any vacancy on the Board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member is eligible for reappointment but may not serve for more than two full 5-year terms.
- (5)--THE-STUDENT-MEMBER-SHALL-SERVE-FOR-A-TERM--OF--1

- (5) THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF 1 YEAR. A STUDENT MEMBER IS ELIGIBLE FOR REAPPOINTMENT BUT MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN 2 FULL 1-YEAR TERMS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
