(i) The vehicle preparation and delivery obligations of the dealer; or

(ii) Any outstanding express or implied new vehicle warranty.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

(Senate Bill 142)

AN ACT concerning

State Scholarship Board - Membership

FOR the purpose of expanding the membership and altering the composition of the State Scholarship Board; and making certain stylistic changes.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education Section 18-202(a) and (b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-202.

- (a) The State Scholarship Board consists of [nine] 10 members appointed by the Governor.
 - (b) Of the members of the Board:
- (1) One shall be the president of a State college or university or his THE PRESIDENT'S nominee;
- (2) One shall be the president of a private college or has THE PRESIDENT'S nominee;
