AND SHALL CONFORM TO APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL FIRE CODES, HEALTH CODES, AND ALL LOCAL ZONING ORDINANCES.

- (4) The [home] HOMES shall accept, from the police and other referral sources in the community, clients for temporary shelter[;].
 - [(5) There shall be 20 beds in the shelter home.]
- (e) The Department of Human Resources may contract with private nonprofit organizations to operate the program.
- (f) The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall give priority access, as appropriate, to women evaluated by the shelter [home] HOMES to institutions under its supervision and shall supply appropriate mental health services.
- (g) The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall not use [this] shelter HOMES as part of [their] ITS discharge service plan.
- (h) Housing may not be provided under this subtitle to applicants for housing who are not residents of Maryland at the time application for housing is made.

127.

- (a) Funds for the establishment and operation of the [model] shelter [home] HOMES shall be as provided in the annual budget.
- (b) The Secretary of Human Resources shall by rule and regulation set charges for services rendered by the [model] shelter [home] HOMES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

(Senate Bill 224)

AN ACT concerning

Harford County - County Property Tax Credits - Little League

FOR the purpose of permitting the governing body of Harford County to provide a county property tax credit for real property owned by a certain little league association; and providing for effective dates for this Act.
