

CHAPTER 166

(Senate Bill 295)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education - Displaced Homemakers

FOR the purpose of ~~altering the meaning of displaced homemaker for purposes of tuition exemptions at certain State institutions of higher education~~, extending the Displaced Homemakers Program to a certain date; and generally relating to educational opportunities for displaced homemakers in the State.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

16-205.

(d) (1) For purposes of this subsection, "displaced homemaker" is an individual who:

~~-(ii)-~~ ~~{I}~~ Has worked for the family in the family home;

~~-(iii)-~~ ~~{II}~~ Is not gainfully employed;

~~-(iv)-~~ ~~{III}~~ Has had, or would have, difficulty finding employment;
