There is a State Advisory Council on Alcoholism Control in the Administration.

8-305.

- (a) (1) The State Advisory Council consists of [24] 25 members appointed by the Governor, in accordance with the federal Comprehensive Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism Prevention, Treatment, and Rehabilitation Act of 1970 and any rules and regulations adopted under it.
- (2) The State Advisory Council shall include representatives from a broad range of agencies and groups that are concerned, directly or indirectly, with alcohol abuse and alcoholism control, such as any of the following:
 - (i) Courts.
 - (ii) Police.
 - (iii) Probation offices.
 - (iv) Clergy.
