BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education Section 18-405 Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-405.

- (a) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, a senatorial scholarship may be used only at any undergraduate, graduate, or professional school in [this] THE State.
 - (b) A senatorial scholarship may be used:
- (1) If the curriculum is approved by the State Board for Higher Education at a degree granting institution of higher education or a hospital diploma school for training registered nurses; and
- (2) For educational expenses as defined by the State Scholarship Board, including:
 - (i) Tuition and mandatory fees; and
 - (ii) Room and board.
- (c) If on-campus housing is available, a senatorial scholarship may not be used to pay for off-campus housing.
 - (d) Each Senator may award not more than 10 percent of the funds available under this subtitle to applicants planning to attend accredited undergraduate, graduate, or professional institutions outside [this] THE State, provided the applicant:
 - (1) [will] WILL be studying in an academic area that is not available in [this] THE State: OR
 - (2) IS A HEARING IMPAIRED PERSON WHO WILL BE STUDYING AT AN INSTITUTION OUTSIDE THE STATE THAT MAKES SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR HEARING IMPAIRED STUDENTS, REGARDLESS-OF-WHETHER-THE-ACADEMIC AREA--IS-NOT-AVAILABLE-IN-THE-STATE AND COMPARABLE SPECIAL PROVISIONS ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO THAT STUDENT AT AN INSTITUTION IN THE STATE.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
