

(B) AN ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIAN REGISTERED BY THE BOARD ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT WILL BE LICENSED FOR THE TERM OF THE CURRENT REGISTRATION.

(C) AN APPLICANT EMPLOYED AS AN ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIAN ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 1985, AND WHO IS NOT REGISTERED BY THE BOARD, MAY BE LICENSED IF THE APPLICANT:

(1) (I) HAS GRADUATED FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE IN ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE OR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH; AND

(II) HAS OBTAINED 12 MONTHS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR

(2) (I) HAS GRADUATED FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE IN THE PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, OR ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES INCLUDING A MINIMUM OF 60 SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS OR THE EQUIVALENT QUARTER CREDIT HOURS OF PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, OR ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; AND

(II) HAS OBTAINED 12 MONTHS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR

(3) (I) HAS GRADUATED FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE THAT INCLUDES A MINIMUM OF 30 SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS OR THE EQUIVALENT IN QUARTER UNITS OF PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, OR ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; AND

(II) HAS OBTAINED 24 MONTHS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR

(4) HAS GRADUATED FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PUBLIC HEALTH OR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SCIENCES THAT INCLUDES;

(I) 30 SEMESTER UNITS OR 45 QUARTER UNITS OF PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, OR ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; AND

(II) 3 MONTHS OF INTERNSHIP APPROVED BY THE BOARD IF NOT PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED; OR

(5) (I) HAS GRADUATED FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE IN A FIELD OTHER THAN PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, OR ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE; AND

(II) HAS OBTAINED 48 MONTHS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR

(6) THE APPLICANT HAS OBTAINED AT LEAST 10 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR
