- (7) (I) HAS OBTAINED AT LEAST 6 MONTHS EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; AND
- (II) HAS PASSED THE EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 5.5-304 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (D) AN APPLICANT WHO BEGINS EMPLOYMENT AS AN ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIAN ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1985 MAY SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD IF THE APPLICANT:
- (1) QUALIFIES FOR THE EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 5.5-304 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (2) TAKES AND ATTAINS A PASSING SCORE ON THE EXAMINATION.
- (E) THE BOARD MAY WAIVE ANY EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE BOARD CONSIDERS THE APPLICANT TO BE RECOGNIZED AS OUTSTANDING IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH. 5.5-304.
- (a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for [certification] LICENSURE is entitled to be examined as provided in this section [and § 5.5-302 of this subtitle].
- (b) AN APPLICANT QUALIFIES TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION IF THE APPLICANT:
- (1) WAS EMPLOYED AS AN ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIAN ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 1985 AND HAS OBTAINED AT LEAST 6 MONTHS OF EXPERIENCE IN ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR
- (2) (I) HAS GRADUATED FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE IN ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE OR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH; AND
- (II) HAS OBTAINED 12 MONTHS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR
- (3) (I) HAS GRADUATED FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE IN THE PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, OR ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES INCLUDING:
- 1. A MINIMUM OF 60 SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS OR THE EQUIVALENT QUARTER CREDIT HOURS OF PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD WHICH INCLUDES AT LEAST 1 LABORATORY COURSE IN 2 OF THE FOLLOWING FIELDS: CHEMISTRY, PHYSICS, AND BIOLOGY; AND
 - 2. A COURSE IN MATHEMATICS; AND
- (II) HAS OBTAINED 12 MONTHS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD; OR
