City of Gaithersburg shall grant and convey a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust on the interior and exterior of the improvements and on the land, where appropriate, in form and substance acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1985:

CHAPTER 240

(Senate Bill 808)

AN ACT concerning

Osteopathic Physicians - Education

FOR the purpose of altering the organization that sets standards for graduation from osteopathy schools to provide that the American Osteopathic Association shall set the graduation standards; providing that either an accrediting organization recognized by the American Medical Association or the American Osteopathic Association may accredit postgraduate training programs for esteopaths osteopathic physicians; and generally relating to the education of esteopaths osteopathic physicians.
