- (A) UNLESS THE BOARD AGREES TO ACCEPT THE SURRENDER OF A LICENSE, A LICENSED SPEECH PATHOLOGIST OR THE HOLDER OF A LIMITED LICENSE MAY NOT SURRENDER THE LICENSE NOR MAY THE LICENSE LAPSE BY OPERATION OF LAW WHILE THE LICENSEE IS UNDER INVESTIGATION OR WHILE CHARGES ARE PENDING AGAINST THE LICENSEE.
- (B) THE BOARD MAY SET CONDITIONS ON ITS AGREEMENT WITH THE LICENSEE UNDER INVESTIGATION OR AGAINST WHOM CHARGES ARE PENDING TO ACCEPT SURRENDER OF THE LICENSE.

(House Bill 97)
