Article 88A - Social Services Administration
Section 65C
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1979 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 88A - Social Services Administration

65C.

(a) (1) The State Administration shall establish and implement and, as necessary, modify a program of general public assistance to needy pregnant women who are not eligible for any other State or federal category of direct cash assistance payments.

(2) The program shall provide State funded assistance payments to women residents of this State who require assistance between the [second] TIME THE PREGNANCY IS MEDICALLY VERIFIED and THE sixth month of pregnancy.

(3) The program shall be known as general public assistance for pregnant women.

(b) In order to be eligible for assistance under this subtitle a woman shall provide IN WRITING medical verification of pregnancy and verification of participation in a prenatal care program.

(c) Eligibility and all other requirements, not set forth in this subtitle, shall be established by rules and regulations promulgated by the State Administration.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
