SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Agriculture

8-701.

- (e) "Pooling agreement" means a written agreement between persons, approved by the Secretary of Agriculture, to perform best management practices and which is intended to solve a mutual pollution problem on different farms.
- (f) "Project" means a project to prevent or control agriculturally related nonpoint source water pollution by establishing best management practices on a farm.

8-704.

(a) (1) State cost sharing in any project may be made available for up to 87 1/2 percent of eligible costs, not to exceed:

(I)--\$10,000---FOR---AN--ANIMAL--WASTE--FACILITY

PROJECT;

(II) \$5,000-in-any-{ene} OTHER project;-or

(III) \$10,000--for--best--management--practices carried-out-under-a-pooling-agreement-

- (I) \$10,000 FOR ANY ONE PROJECT; OR
- (II) \$20,000 FOR ANY BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES CARRIED OUT UNDER A POOLING AGREEMENT.
- (2) State cost sharing funds may be made available for any project if:
- (i) The Department of Agriculture, the soil conservation district, and a person have executed an agreement
