CHAPTER 294

(House Bill 345)

AN ACT concerning

Tax Collectors - Payment of Judgments

FOR the purpose of repealing certain limitations on payments by a collector or surety of a collector of money due the State, in suit or judgment.

BY repealing

Article - Tax - Property

Acts of the General Assembly of 1985)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Tax - Property

[4-404.

Payment by a collector or the surety of a collector of money due the State, in suit or in judgment, is not valid unless made to:

- (1) the Attorney General;
- (2) the State Treasurer; or
- (3) a sheriff authorized to receive the money because of an execution issued by a court.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect February 1, 1986.
