

(I) DETERMINE THE VALUE THAT WOULD HAVE RESULTED IF THE REVALUATION HAD OCCURRED FOR THE 1ST YEAR OF THE 3-YEAR CYCLE;

(II) DETERMINE THE VALUE THAT WOULD HAVE RESULTED IF THE REVALUATION HAD OCCURRED FOR THE 1ST YEAR OF THE PRECEDING 3-YEAR CYCLE; AND

[[ii]] (III) adjust the phased in value for each of the years remaining in the 3-year cycle to reflect the change that results from the revaluation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect February 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 296

(House Bill 370)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Interchangeable Registrations

FOR the purpose of creating uniformity within the interchangeable ~~classifications;---increasing---fees---to---correspond---with registration-fees-for-comparable-vehicle-classifications;~~ classifications of certain motor vehicle registration plates; altering fees for certain classes of motor vehicle registration plates; and generally relating to interchangeable registrations.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13-944(b), and 13-946(b)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

(b) For Class 1A (dealer) registration plates, the annual registration fee is[: ] \$20 \$10 FOR EACH REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED TO THE APPLICANT.
