

(2) To take those actions which may be necessary to effectuate the Chesapeake Bay Commission Agreement on behalf of the State of Maryland.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not take effect until a similar Act is passed by the General Assemblies of Virginia and Pennsylvania; that the Commonwealths of Virginia and Pennsylvania are requested to concur in this Act of the General Assembly of Maryland by the passage of a similar Act; that the Department of Legislative Reference shall notify the appropriate officials of the Commonwealths of Virginia and Pennsylvania of the passage of this Act; and that upon the concurrence in this Act by the Commonwealths of Virginia and Pennsylvania, the Governor of the State of Maryland shall issue a proclamation declaring this Act valid and effective.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1985.
