SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(w) (1) The Sheriff of Washington County shall receive a salary of ~~[\$23,000]~~ ~~\$28,000~~ ~~\$26,680~~ \$28,000. He may appoint an office deputy at a salary set by the County Commissioners. He may appoint the following additional employees who shall receive not less than the salaries indicated: two deputies--~~\$2,400~~ ~~\$1,600~~ \$2,400 and \$50 per month each for the use of their automobiles; one secretary--~~\$1,800~~ ~~\$800~~ \$1,800; a chief warden of the jail--~~\$2,400~~ ~~\$1,600~~ \$2,400; an assistant warden--~~\$2,100~~ ~~\$850~~ \$2,100; an attorney to the Sheriff--\$600; and a cook--~~\$1,800~~ ~~\$800~~ \$1,800; additional special deputies--same salary as deputies. Salaries set by this section, except the Sheriff's salary are minimum salaries and may be increased from time to time by the County Commissioners.
