He may appoint the following additional employees who shall receive not less than the salaries indicated: two deputies—\$2,400 \$2,400 and \$50 per month each for the use of their automobiles; one secretary—\$1,800 \$2,400; a chief warden of the jail—\$2,400 \$1,800; a chief warden of the jail—\$2,400 \$1,600 \$2,400; an assistant warden—\$2,100 \$800 \$2,100; an attorney to the Sheriff—\$600; and a cook—\$1,800 \$1,800; additional special deputies—same salary as deputies.
