[(v)] (VI) Independence Day; [(vi)] (VII) Labor Day; [(vii)] (VIII) Columbus Day; [(viii)] (IX) Veterans' Day;

[(ix)] (X) Thanksgiving Day; and

[(x)] (XI) Christmas Day.

- (2) When a legal holiday differs from the corresponding federal holiday, a banking institution:
  - (i) May be closed on both holidays; and
  - (ii) Shall be closed on one of the holidays.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 381

(House Bill 913)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Driver's License - Epilepsy

FOR the purpose of providing that if the Motor Vehicle Administration suspends, revokes, or refuses to issue or renew a driver's license of an individual under certain circumstances because of the individual's epilepsy, the period of suspension, revocation, or refusal to issue or renew may not exceed a certain period of time; providing certain exceptions to the provisions of this Act; and generally relating to the suspension, revocation, or refusal to issue or renew a driver's license of an individual because of the individual's epilepsy.
