## Article 44A - Housing Authorities

"8A.

- (g) (1) In this section "assisted family housing" has the definition provided by the Montgomery County government.
- (2) The Housing Opportunities Commission shall hold a public hearing on its proposed assisted family housing.
- (3) The public hearing shall be publicized by a display advertisement in 2 newspapers of general circulation in Montgomery County at least 15 days prior to the public hearing.
- (4) The Housing Opportunities Commission, subsequent to the public hearing, shall issue a report of its finding and conclusions on its proposed assisted family housing which was the subject of the public hearing.
- (5) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO PROPOSED SCATTERED SITES AND MODERATELY PRICED DWELLING UNITS, AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED BY MONTGOMERY COUNTY LAW, THAT ARE ACQUIRED FOR ASSISTED FAMILY HOUSING, PROPOSED BY THE HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES COMMISSION, AND FOR WHICH A PUBLIC HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED BY MONTGOMERY COUNTY LAW.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
