(II) THE CARROLL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL SET THE ADDITIONAL MEMBER'S SALARY ON A PER DIEM BASIS AND PROVIDE A TERM OF OFFICE FOR THAT MEMBER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

## CHAPTER 395

(House Bill 1032)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Fire Police - Duties

FOR the purpose of authorizing deputy sheriffs acting as fire police in Carroll County to perform traffic control duties for certain public functions upon the request and approval by the Carroll County sheriff.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 87 - Sheriffs Section 53(b)(1) Annotated Code of Maryland (1979 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 87 - Sheriffs

53.

(b) (1) The provisions of this subtitle are applicable in Carroll County, Cecil County, Frederick County, and Kent County, respectively, except as modified in this section. Twelve members of each fire company may be designated by the captain, chief, or other commanding officer of the fire companies of these counties, respectively, and recommended to be appointed deputy sheriffs by the sheriffs of the several counties. The powers of the deputies are limited to those necessary to perform their duties when functioning as fire police at parades, accidents, floods or other emergencies, or at any public function conducted by, or under the auspices of, any volunteer fire company, or by the sheriff's department. Such powers may be exercised in incorporated cities, towns, counties, or on State roadways but only under the discretion and control of the chief of the police force of the
