

3. MAY MODIFY THE HISTORICAL DAILY AVERAGE CONSUMPTION CALCULATION BASED UPON ANY APPROPRIATE EVIDENCE SUBMITTED BY THE OWNER; AND

4. MAY NOT BASE A FINAL BILL ON ESTIMATED USAGE FOR 2 CONSECUTIVE 6-MONTH PERIODS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
