- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "FLOATING HOME" MEANS ANY VESSEL, WHETHER SELF-PROPELLED OR NOT, THAT:
- (I) IS USED, DESIGNATED, OR OCCUPIED AS A PERMANENT DWELLING UNIT OR PLACE OF BUSINESS OR FOR ANY PRIVATE OR SOCIAL CLUB; AND
- THAN 3,000 SQUARE FEET, WHICH IS BASED ON THE RATIO OF THE HABITABLE SPACE OF THE VESSEL MEASURED IN CUBIC FEET AND THE DRAFT OF THE VESSEL MEASURED IN FEET OF DEPTH.
 - (2) "FLOATING HOME" INCLUDES A STRUCTURE THAT:
- (I) IS CONSTRUCTED ON A BARGE THAT IS PRIMARILY IMMOBILE AND OUT OF NAVIGATION; OR
- (II) FUNCTIONS SUBSTANTIALLY AS A LAND STRUCTURE WHILE THE VESSEL IS MOORED OR DOCKED IN THE STATE.
- (B) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CALVERT COUNTY, CHARLES COUNTY, AND ST. MARY'S COUNTY ARE AUTHORIZED TO ADOPT AND TO AMEND FROM TIME TO TIME A CODE TO REGULATE AND RESTRICT THE MOORING, DOCKING, ANCHORING, AND INSTALLING IN THE WATERS OF THE RESPECTIVE COUNTY OF ANY STRUCTURE-OR-VESSEL-THAT-FUNCTIONS PRIMARILY-AS-A-LAND-STRUCTURE FLOATING HOME, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THAT CODE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THAT CODE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
