- (1) SHALL ALLOW SPORT FISHERMEN AND COMMERCIAL FISHERMEN TO TAKE, POSSESS, SELL, AND TRANSPORT STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH; BUT
- (2) MAY NOT REMOVE THE MORATORIUMS FOR SPORT FISHERMEN OR COMMERCIAL FISHERMEN WITHOUT REMOVING THE SAME MORATORIUMS FOR THE OTHER GROUP OF FISHERMEN.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

## CHAPTER 436

(House Bill 1330)

AN ACT concerning

Licenses and Registration - Property Line Surveyors

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Board of Registration for Professional Land Surveyors from registering any new applicants as property line surveyors after a certain date; permitting property line surveyors who are registered before that certain date to renew their registration; providing that registration fees may not be assessed against property line surveyors after that certain date; and clarifying language.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(d) (1) [Any] BEFORE JULY 1, 1988 1990, ANY person may be registered as a property line surveyor upon completion of the following requirements:
