(III) IN CARROLL COUNTY, IN ADDITION TO THE APPLICANT'S RESIDENTIAL STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE SHALL REMAIN VALID ONLY FOR AS LONG AS THE RESIDENT APPLICANT REMAINS A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 440

(House Bill 1369)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Death of Licensee

FOR the purpose of requiring in Carroll County the executor or administrator of a deceased licensee's estate to make application to a Board of License Commissioners within a certain period of time after the death of the licensee to continue the business on a temporary basis; and authorizing in Carroll County the Board of License Commissioners to grant an additional period of time to executors or administrators of a deceased licensee's estate to operate the business when it is shown that such estate cannot be settled within established legal time requirements because of litigation.
