CHAPTER 472

(House Bill 1649)

AN ACT concerning

Somerset County - Treasurer - Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the treasurer of Somerset County; requiring-the-County-Commissioners-of Somerset-County-to-periodically-set-a-salary-of-not-less than-a-certain-amount-after-a-certain-date; and providing that this Act does not affect the incumbent.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 25 - County Commissioners Section 51(r) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

51.

(r) $-(\frac{1}{2})$ - The annual salary of the county treasurer of Somerset County is [\$15,000] \$18,500.

(2)--SUBSEQUENT--T0--1986,--THE-COUNTY--COMMISSIONERS SHALL--SET-THE-SALARY-FOR-THE-ENSUING-TERMS-OF-OFFICE,-BUT-IT-MAY NOT-BE-LESS-THAN-\$18,500-

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35, of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Somerset County Treasurer in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Somerset County Treasurer shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
