SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14-101.

(c) "Director" means the director of the local department [of social services in the political subdivision where the adult requiring protective services lives].

14-102.

(b) To implement this policy the Secretary [of Human Resources], with the advice of the State Director on Aging and the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, is responsible for establishing and supervising a program of adult protective services to be administered by each local department [of social services].

14-201.

- (a) The Secretary [of Human Resources], with the advice of the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene and the State Director of the Office on Aging, shall develop, supervise, and cause each LOCAL department [of social services] to implement a program of protective services for disabled persons and other adults who because of physical or mental disabilities require assistance in providing for their daily needs.
- (c) (2) The protective services program shall be funded as provided in the State budget. However, this [subtitle] TITLE does not prevent any appropriation of additional funds by any county[, including Baltimore City,] for adult protective services.
