

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each supervisory and sales position in the classified service existing and filled on the effective date of this Act shall remain part of the classified service until it becomes vacant. As each position becomes vacant, it shall no longer be part of the classified service.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Secretaries of Personnel and Public Safety and Correctional Services may establish, for submission as part of the Fiscal Year 1987 budget request, an incentive based compensation plan for supervisory or sales personnel at State Use Industries.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 482

(House Bill 1684)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Cruelty to Animals

FOR the purpose of authorizing in Baltimore County the enforcement of certain laws concerning cruelty to animals by an organization approved by the Baltimore County government.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments
Section 67 and 67A
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1982 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

67.

If the owner or custodian of an animal is convicted of any act of animal cruelty, the judge may use his own discretion in ordering the removal of that animal or animals for their
