- (C) ALL GRANT AWARDS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL IDENTIFIED AND BRIEFLY DESCRIBED IN ANNUAL REPORTS DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES FOR GRANTS AWARDED THIS SUBTITLE AND BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND 5-1102 OF § 5-1103 OF THIS MENTAL HYGIENE FOR GRANTS AWARDED UNDER THESE REPORTS SHALL BE PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBTITLE. SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
- (D) IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GRANT PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, EACH YEAR THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM A DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE PREVENTION AWARENESS WEEK AND A CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AWARENESS WEEK TO FOCUS PUBLIC ATTENTION ON THESE PROBLEMS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
